- Application which indicates your personal participation and gives your consent to transfer non-exclusive rights to use your article (please see a standard form attached);*
- edited article (please see the formatting requirements);*

•if you do not have a scientific degree - certified Article Reference Letter issued by your scientific advisor (electronic format, scanned).

Article Formatting Requirements:

1) Materials are to be submitted in «doc» or «rtf» format of the Microsoft Word processor; length of the article ranging from 2 to 10 pages; 20 mm margins; Times New Roman font, size 14, 1,5-spaced.

2) Title of the article IN CAPITAL LETTERS IN THE MIDDLE; one space below – the author's name and sir name, name of the establishment where he or she studies or works (please indicate your position, scientific degree or year of study, faculty), then your personal e-mail address which will be indicated on the Internet page and used to further communicate with the author of the materials submitted (mandatory!). One space below please list key words of your article (not more than six words which mark your research) and, one space below, the text of the article.

At the end of the article please name your scientific advisor: name, middle and sir name, scientific degree, their position (for those who do not themselves have a scientific degree).

3) Reference notes should be given in square brackets and indicate the sequence number of the work cited and the page of the respective source, for instance, [1, p.23]. The sequence number of the references have to correspond to the sequence number in the Works Cited section. The Works Cited section should be a list of works cited which follows the caption "Works Cited" and contains bibliographical description of each source.

Please do not use automatic footnotes in the text and automatic paragraph numbering, inter alia in the Works Cited section.

4) File name in the electronic format has to bear the sir name of the author in English transliteration.

Nota Bene! The authors of the articles shall be responsible for the material contained in the article. The Organizational Committee shall have the right to reject participation without stating reasons, should the rules of participation in the Conference be violated or should the Committee disapprove of the materials of the article.
